Cathedral Ridge Rate Sheet 2021

Thank you for your interest in booking a stay at Cathedral Ridge. The physical safety of our guests and staff is our highest priority and shapes our hospitality ministry in the following ways:

January – March: Cathedral Ridge is open to individuals, families and small group gatherings up to 16. Our lodge operates at 50% capacity with rooms limited to single occupancy or family units. Our cottages are limited to double occupancy or family units. All gatherings are outdoors except in inclement weather. Masks are required indoors at all times except in sleeping areas and for outdoor gatherings. Meals are served individually packaged take-out style.

April and following: Cathedral Ridge will serve groups larger than 16 when a COVID-19 test is available to the general public that provides a one hour response with 95% reliability rating. Group organizers will be responsible for communicating this expectation and providing documentation that each participant has taken a test and received a clear reading on the day of arrival. Hopeful that such technology is imminent, Cathedral Ridge will accept bookings in April for groups larger than 16. However, if such a test is not available, gatherings larger than 16 will be canceled with 30 days notice and deposit fully refunded. Due to the gap time between potential exposure and infection, masks will continue to be required as a precaution.

When a vaccine is available to the general public, the Executive Director shall determine the date when proof of vaccination will be required for staff and guests. Group organizers will be responsible for presenting proof of vaccination for participants on the day of arrival. Exceptions will be granted for those who provide a medical contraindication letter from a physician.

Our Commitment to Guests

While restrictions and guidelines cannot remove 100% of the risk, we understand that these practices play a role in keeping our community safe and offering our campus as sanctuary.

Our facilities are cleaned and disinfected according to COVID-19 standards set forth by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment for lodging establishments. Lodging spaces are vacant for a 24 hour minimum between guests. Any staff member that is symptomatic or has knowingly been exposed to COVID-19 in the previous 14 days will self-isolate and granted paid sick leave. Staff undergo daily temperature checks and symptom monitoring. We wear masks, wash hands frequently and wear fresh gloves for every cooking and cleaning activity. If any staff or concurrent guest reports symptoms during or within 14 days of your visit, we will contact you.

Our Guests' Commitment to Cathedral Ridge

No guest that is symptomatic or has knowingly been exposed to the virus in the previous 14 days will visit campus. Guests will self-monitor symptoms, and upon any indication of the following depart within the hour. We will prorate charges and refund accordingly. Symptoms include: Fever - Dry cough - Shortness of Breath - Chills - Loss of taste or smell- Sore Throat - Muscle aches. While these symptoms can also be related to non-COVID-19 related issues, we proceed with an abundance of caution. If a guest suspects or tests positive for COVID-19 within 14 days of departure, Cathedral Ridge will be notified. Guests will keep a mask on their person as they enjoy the outdoors, and wear the mask for any interactions with staff and guests.



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Lodging Prices

Lodging prices are per night with two night minimum and include one meeting space. Check-in begins at 12 pm and check-out is 10 am unless previously arranged. Linens are provided and cottages include basic kitchen supplies and grill access. Due to coronavirus prevention, lodging capacity will be limited and based upon the number of households represented.

\$110 Lupine Lodge room

- Hotel style room with 2 queen beds, private $\frac{3}{4}$ bath. Access to shared break room with mini-fridge, microwave, coffee and toaster oven. No pets, please.

\$350 Snowberry Cottage

- Modern 4 bedrooms (8 beds), 2 baths; master suite with king bed and private deck; gas fireplace; full kitchen; two decks. No pets, please.

\$300 Gooseberry Cottage

- 5 bedrooms (10 beds), 2 baths; wood burning fireplace; full kitchen (no dishwasher); dogs welcome

\$200 Barberry Cottage

- 3 bedrooms and loft (12 beds), 2 baths; full kitchen (no dishwasher); large sunroom; dogs welcome

\$100 Hermitage (seasonal)

- A hike-in secluded camper with a deck and grill. Private shower access in bunkhouse.

\$50 Apartment

- Small apartment with queen bed, $\frac{3}{4}$ bath, seating area and kitchenette with refrigerator, microwave, toaster and coffeemaker. Dogs welcome.

\$50 BYO tent or camper

- picnic table and private restroom/shower access; no hook-ups

\$50 Bunkhouse

- Dormitory style accommodations can sleep 68. **Optional \$10 linen fee per person for bunkhouses. Linens must be requested in advance and includes sheets, blanket, pillow, bath towel, hand towel & washcloth.*

Rates inclusive of set-up, wi-fi, audio-visual equipment, and beverage service.

Visa, Mastercard and Discover accepted with a 3% transaction fee.
