Cathedral Ridge Policies and Rates 2021

Thank you for your interest in visiting Cathedral Ridge. During this COVID season, our hospitality ministry strives to minimize the risk of transmission through observing the latest guidelines recommended by public health experts.

Our Commitment to Guests

Our facilities are cleaned and disinfected according to COVID-19 standards set forth by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment for lodging establishments. Every staff member has received a COVID-19 vaccination. Any staff member that develops symptoms of illness will not work and is granted paid sick leave. We wear masks indoors, wash hands frequently and practice physical distancing. If staff or a guest tests positive during or within 7 days of your visit, we contact you.

Our Guests' Commitment to Cathedral Ridge

Cathedral Ridge requires guests to be vaccinated for COVID-19 or to present a negative test result taken within 48 hours of arrival. Children 4 years and younger are exempted. The primary contact will be responsible for communicating this expectation to their group and providing proof of vaccinations and/or negative COVID test results on the day of arrival.

No guest that is symptomatic will visit campus. Guests will self-monitor symptoms, and upon any indication of the following depart the same day. We will prorate charges and refund accordingly. Symptoms include: Fever - Dry cough - Shortness of Breath - Chills - Loss of taste or smell- Sore Throat -Muscle aches. While these symptoms can also be related to non-COVID-19 related issues, we proceed with an abundance of caution. If a guest tests positive within 7 days of departure, the guest commits to notify Cathedral Ridge as soon as possible.

Guests will wear masks in the dining hall except when seated at their table. For interactions among their own group, guests will abide by current mask and distancing requirements set forth by the Public Health or Executive Orders found on <https://covid19.colorado.gov/public-health-executive-orders>.

Lodging and Dining Guidelines

Until children are eligible for vaccination, groups that include children will be limited to 50% occupancy in the lodge (12 rooms). When children are included, bunkhouses and cottages are limited to single households.

Group meal service will be provided by masked and gloved staff serving buffet-style to guests. Masks will be required in the dining hall except when seated. Cottage guests may order pre-prepped meals delivered to cottages, or eat in the dining hall when group service is provided.

Groups booking outdoor gatherings for day use only have no capacity limits.

Lodging Prices

Lodging prices are per night with two night minimum and include one meeting space. Check-in after 3 pm and check-out by 11 am unless previously arranged. Linens are provided and cottages include basic kitchen supplies and grill access. Due to our remote location, cell reception is limited. If you need internet access during your stay, a public computer is available in the office.

\$110 Lupine Lodge room

- Hotel style room with 2 queen beds, private $\frac{3}{4}$ bath. No pets, please.

\$350 Snowberry Cottage

- Modern 4 bedrooms (8 beds), 2 baths on a single level; master suite with king bed and private deck; gas fireplace; full kitchen; two decks. No pets, please.

\$300 Gooseberry Cottage

- 5 bedrooms (10 beds), 2 baths on two levels; wood burning fireplace; full kitchen (no dishwasher); dogs welcome

\$200 Barberry Cottage (unavailable June 1-August 9)

- 3 bedrooms and loft (9 beds), 2 baths; full kitchen (no dishwasher); large sunroom; outdoor firepit; dogs welcome

\$100 Hermitage (June-October)

- A hike-in secluded camper with a deck and grill. Private shower access in bunkhouse.

\$50 Bunkhouses are open for single households. Guests provide their own pillows and linens.

\$50 BYO tent or camper with picnic table and private restroom/shower access; no hook-ups

Meal Prices

Fresh and healthy meals that accommodate gluten free, dairy free and vegan diets.

Half price for kids ages 5-12. 4 and under free.

Day Use

- Day Passes are free to individuals and families with meal purchase, reservation required
- Day Group Meeting Room Rate or Second Meeting Room for Overnight Groups: \$250
- Private event in Sage Dining Hall: \$250 Rental + \$25 per person for customized menu
- High Ropes/Low Ropes/Archery/S'mores: pricing varies based on time and group size
